**I. ROLL CALL**

Chairman Bauchiero called the meeting to order at 8:04 AM and asked Mr. Hawkins to take a silent roll call. Chairman Bauchiero stated that both he and Mr. Murphy would be regular voting members and then appointed Mr. Winne and Mr. O'Hara as the alternate voting members.

**II. NEW BUSINESS**


**File #2012-19 – Request from the Board of Selectmen for an 8-24 report to increase bonding for road and drainage improvements to almost nine (9) miles of town roads, and for the rehabilitation of the Boston Neck Road bridge.**

Chairman Bauchiero asked Mr. Hawkins and Mr. Turbet to explain what the Commission was being asked to do for this 8-24 report. Mr. Hawkins explained the need for the special meeting and the reason they were being asked to provide a recommendation per Connecticut General Statutes §8-24. Mr. Hawkins handed out a memorandum prepared by Mr. Turbet describing the roads proposed to be worked on and the bridge. Mr. Turbet explained the Board of Selectmen are seeking to increase current bonding by \$4,492,000 which includes \$3,742,000 for paving approximately 9 miles of Town roads and \$750,000 for the rehabilitation of the Boston Neck Road bridge. A brief discussion followed regarding the condition of the roads and bridge proposed to be worked on. Chairman Bauchiero asked for a motion; Mr. Winne made a motion to approve file 2012-19 pursuant to §8-24 of the Connecticut General Statutes, for road and drainage improvements to approximately 9 miles of town roads and to rehabilitate the Boston Neck Road bridge as outlined in Mr. Turbet's memorandum. Mr. O'Hara seconded, motion passed unanimously (4-0).

**III. ADJOURNMENT**

A motion was made and seconded to adjourn the October 23, 2012 special meeting at 8:15 AM.
