

meals prepared on site Wednesday and Thursdays and a light breakfast daily. She noted that since the new Center opened in July, volunteers have logged 2,132 hours of service. The Hartford Foundation for Public Giving awarded the Center a grant to purchase MySeniorCenter technology which gives the Center the ability to track membership and various statistics. There are 1,067 registered members. She reviewed her budget, noting she is requesting three more hours for the assistant to the Director.

Youth Services Director Peter Black is currently on sick leave, but it was reported that he is doing well and expects to attend the next meeting.

It was noted that budgets are submitted to the Director of Finance and the Board of Selectmen. The final budgets are then submitted to the Board of Finance. A calendar of budget review meetings will be distributed. The Commission usually attends the budget meeting scheduled for social services, and supports the new budget requests.

The meeting was adjourned. The next meeting will be Feb. 10.
